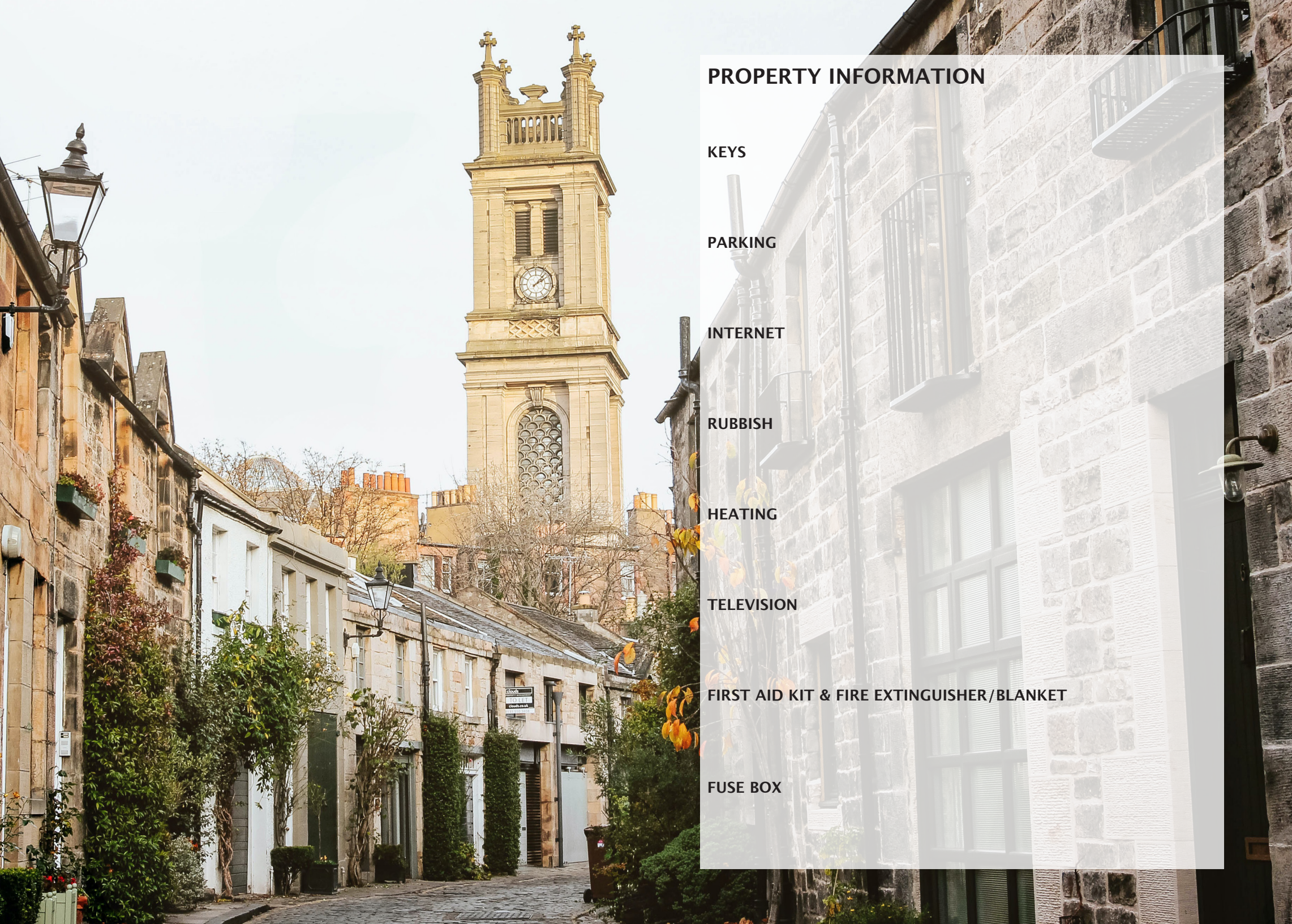

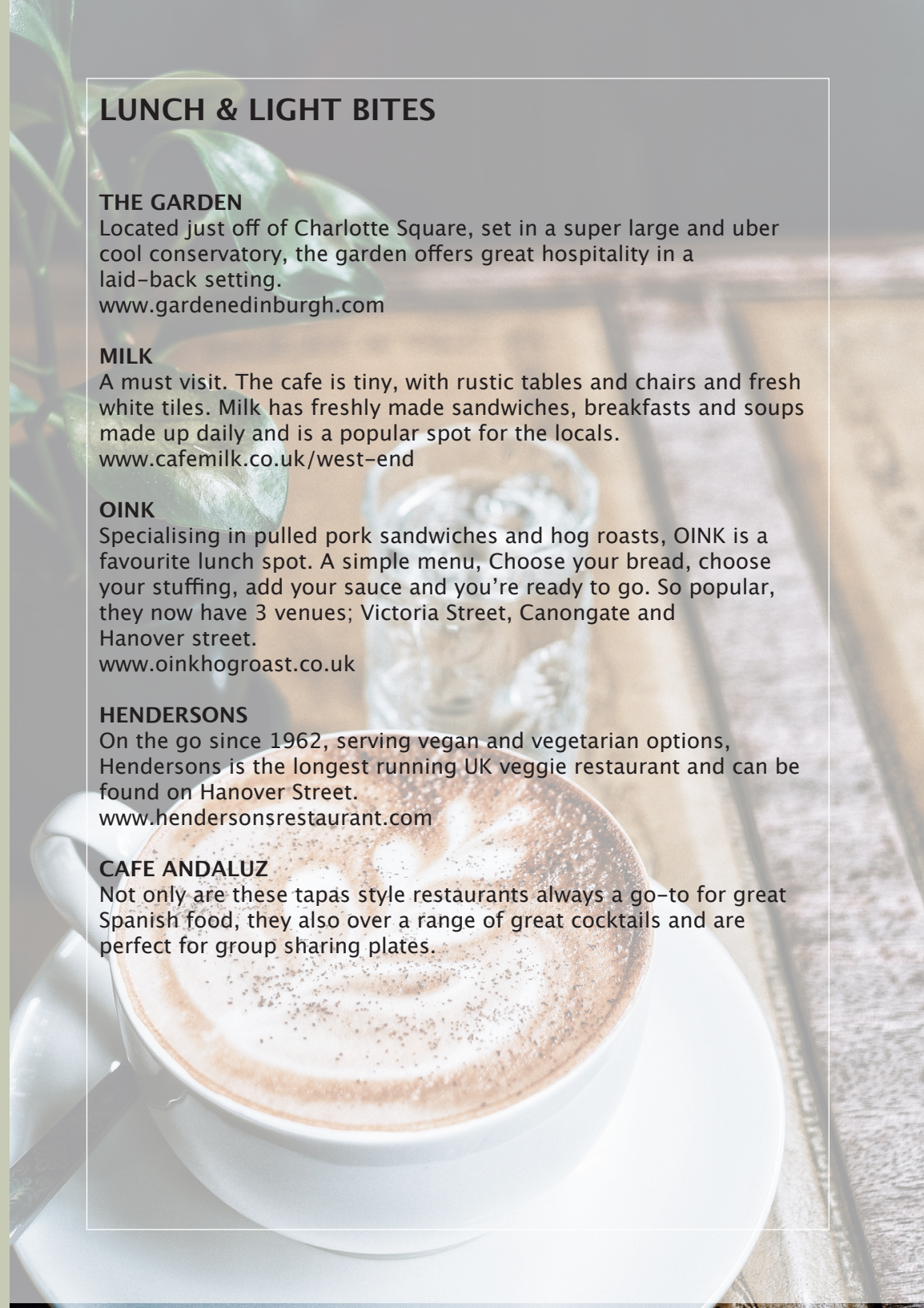
HENDERSONS
